## **Link found between Glaucoma and Tinnitus**

A recent study published in the journal of glaucoma from Taiwan suggests a possible link between Primary Open-Angle Glaucoma (POAG) and Tinnitus – a condition that causes a sensation similar to ringing, buzzing, hissing, chirping or whistling in the ears. Tinnitus was reportedly found to be also linked to hearing loss, hyperlipidemia, rheumatoid arthritis and idiopathic intracranial hypertension.

More research is necessary to understand these relationships.
