Rethinking How We Diagnose
Normal Tension Glaucoma

Glaucoma has long been associated with elevated eye pressure, but a growing number of patients develop optic nerve damage and vision loss even when their pressure readings look completely normal. This condition, known as Normal Tension Glaucoma, presents a unique diagnostic puzzle, and getting the diagnosis right is critical before committing a patient to lifelong treatment.

This lecture walks through a modern, comprehensive approach to Normal Tension Glaucoma – one that goes well beyond a single pressure check in the clinic.

Dr. Irfan N. Kherani is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Ophthalmology and Vision Sciences at the University of Toronto and a fellowship-trained glaucoma and anterior segment surgeon. He provides comprehensive medical, laser, and surgical care, with a specialized focus on minimally invasive and complex glaucoma surgery, as well as a dedicated vision rehabilitation program for patients with advanced disease.
